1 Corinthians 13 – Change the Infinitives

A. Translate each infinitive verb into your first language.

B. Write the correct form of each verb on the right:

4 Love **BE** patient and **BE** kind. Love doesn't **ENVY**.

Love doesn't **BRAG**, **BE** not proud,

5 doesn't **BEHAVE** itself inappropriately, doesn't **SEEK** its own way,

is not **PROVOKE**, **TAKE** no account of evil;

6 doesn't **REJOICE** in unrighteousness, but **REJOICE** with the truth;

7 **BEAR** all things, **BELIEVE** all things, **HOPE** all things,

and **ENDURE** all things.

8 Love never **FAIL**. But where there **BE** prophecies,

they will be **DO AWAY WITH**.

Where there **BE** various languages, they will **CEASE**.

Where there **BE** knowledge, it will be **DO AWAY WITH**.

9 For we **KNOW** in part and we **PROPHECY** in part;

10 but when that which **BE** complete has **COME**,

then that which **BE** partial will be **DO AWAY WITH**.

11 When I **BE** a child, I **SPEAK** as a child, I **FEEL** as a child,

I **THINK** as a child. Now that I have **BECOME** a man,

I have **PUT AWAY** childish things.

12 For now we **SEE** in a mirror, dimly, but then face to face.

Now I **KNOW** in part, but then I will **KNOW** fully,

even as I was also fully **KNOW**.

13 But now faith, hope, and love **REMAIN** – these three.

The greatest of these **BE** love.
