1 Corinthians 13 - Change the Infinitives

4 Love <b>BE</b> patient and <b>BE</b> kind. Love doesn't <b>ENVY</b> .	
Love doesn't <b>BRAG</b> , <b>BE</b> not proud,	
5 doesn't <b>BEHAVE</b> itself inappropriately, doesn't <b>SEEK</b> its own way,	
is not <b>PROVOKE</b> , <b>TAKE</b> no account of evil;	
6 doesn't REJOICE in unrighteousness, but REJOICE with the truth;	
7 BEAR all things, BELIEVE all things, HOPE all things, and ENDURE all things.	
8 Love never <b>FAIL</b> . But where there <b>8E</b> prophecies,	
they will be DO AWAY WITH.	
Where there <b>BE</b> various languages, they will <b>CEASE</b> .	
Where there <b>BE</b> knowledge, it will be <b>DO AWAY WITH</b> .	
9 For we KNOW in part and we PROPHESY in part;	
10 but when that which <b>BE</b> complete has <b>COME</b> ,	
then that which <b>BE</b> partial will be <b>DO AWAY WITH</b> .	
11 When I <b>BE</b> a child, I <b>SPEAK</b> as a child, I <b>FEEL</b> as a child,	
I THINK as a child. Now that I have BECOME a man,	
I have <b>PUT AWAY</b> childish things.	
12 For now we <b>SEE</b> in a mirror, dimly, but then face to face.	
Now I KNOW in part, but then I will KNOW fully,	
even as I was also fully <b>KNOW</b> .	
13 But now faith, hope, and love <b>REMAIN</b> – these three.	
The greatest of these <b>8E</b> love.
