

Answers

The material in PPP may be used by teachers in the classroom or given as homework; alternatively, students may wish to use it for self-study or learning with a partner or small group. This is possible because all the worksheets have answers. Many of the worksheets have an answer page which is attached, while the answers for worksheets that are taken from a book – e.g. 'Big Grammar Book' – can be found at the back of that book. For ease of use, you will find a separate folder containing all answer sections from the relevant books.

How to use this folder

- 1. Save the PPP folder to your computer or device. Open the folder and click index.html
- pdf files open with a pdf viewer, e.g. Adobe Acrobat Reader DC, which is available here: https://get.adobe.com/uk/reader/
- 3. jpg and png files open with any image viewer
- 4. pptx files open with Microsoft PowerPoint or OpenOffice.org, among others
- 5. html files open with your default browser
- 6. Searching for a particular resource: the material in this folder covers a huge range of different topics. Try searching for a topic by using the search box in the main folder or in each subfolder. For example, if you are looking for material connected with 'intonation', you could type 'intonation' in the search box in the first folder and you would find four worksheets on this topic three at Elementary level and one at Intermediate level. You could also search using the Ctrl-F (PC) / Command-F (Mac) shortcut on your keyboard
